Before getting started, remember to:

Customize your Liver Life Walk Experience Center

Once you are signed up for an event, customize your Virtual Liver Life Walk Experience Center by adding a picture and share why you are fundraising. If you or a loved one has liver disease be sure to include a picture of yourself or a picture with that person.

FUNdraising Ideas:

Host a virtual movie night

Plan a Netflix Party virtual fundraiser. Invite friends, family and classmates to attend and donate \$5 to your walk team.

Make your own t-shirt

Make your own Virtual Liver Life Walk Team T-shirt that you can sell. Put the proceeds towards your Virtual Liver Life Walk goal!

Write letters asking for donations

Write letters to family and friends asking them to donate.

Ask your teacher for permission to write a letter to your classmates about why you are participating in the Virtual Liver Life Walk. Be sure to include information about the great work the American Liver Foundation is doing to end liver disease one day.
